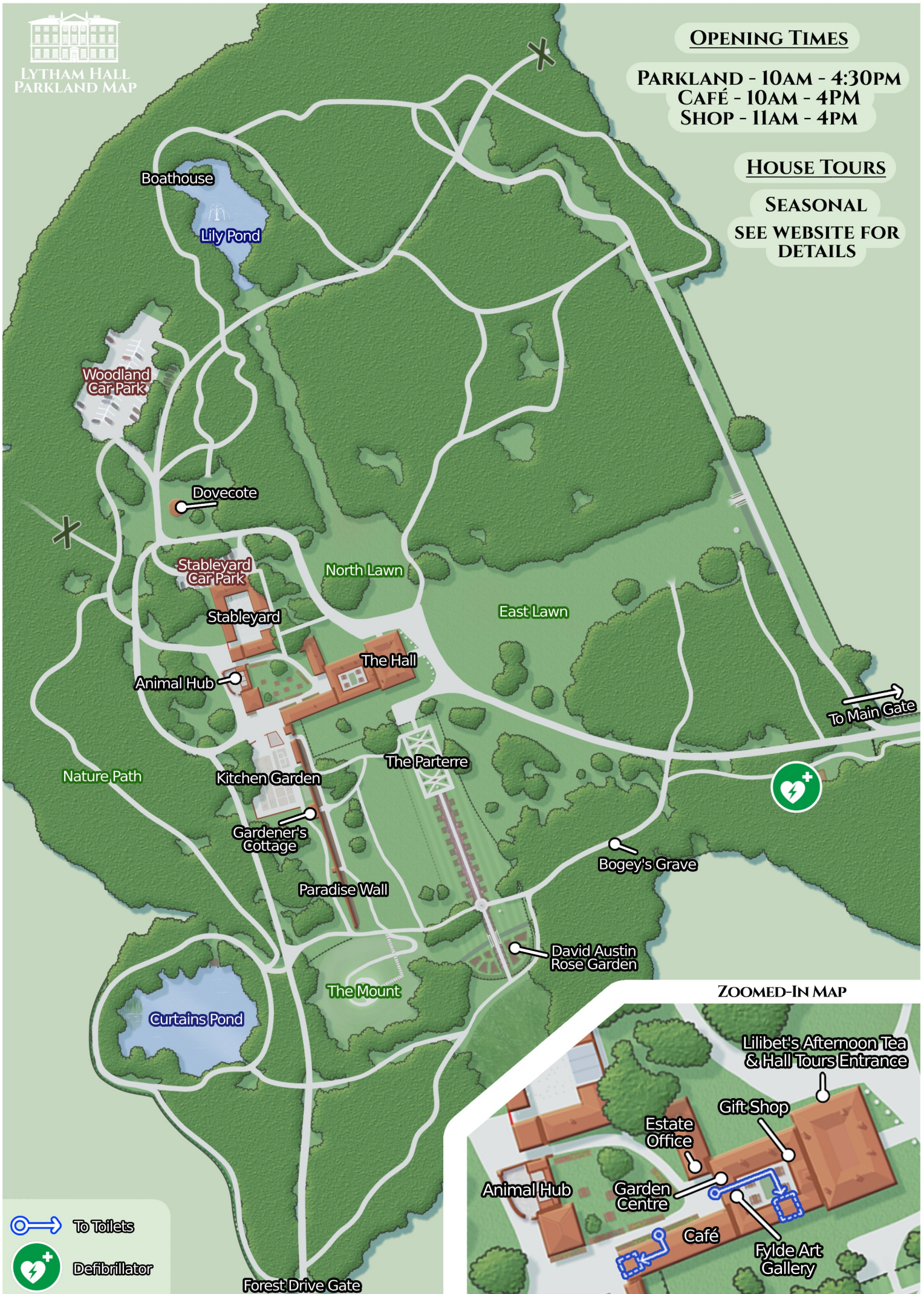

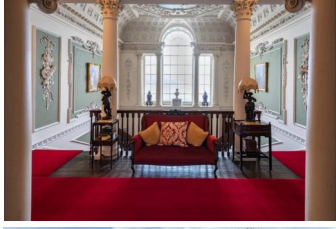

What to do at Lytham Hall



HALL OPENINGS - The Hall is open from 12pm till 4pm (last entry 3pm) 7 days a week. Check the **WEBSITE FOR CLOSERS** as the Hall can be closed for events and weddings).



PARKLANDS - Set within **78 acres of historic woodland**, Lytham Hall offers stunning grounds incorporating the new Parterre and South Prospect Gardens, the Lake, and Curtains Pond. With over **4 km of recently created pathways**, there's plenty to explore. Visit *The Mount* (the highest point in Lytham), discover the 19th-century Dovecote, or enjoy a peaceful wander through the Kitchen Gardens.



SHOP - Our Hall shop offers a wonderful range of **Lytham Hall branded produce**, including preserves, condiments, chocolates, cakes, biscuits, cooking sauces, and savoury treats. You'll also find soft furnishings, branded clothing, artwork, and specialty teas and coffees from Atkinsons of Lancaster.



CAFÉ / ICE-CREAM PARLOUR / AFTERNOON TEA - The Café at Lytham Hall is located in the West Wing, with access to a charming lawn area featuring attractive borders and picnic tables set in the heart of the estate. Additional seating is available in our inner courtyard, and the café is **dog friendly**. Our Ice-Cream Parlour, situated by the lawn, serves delicious Lakes Ice-Cream. For a special treat, enjoy Afternoon Tea in the beautiful Georgian Library – **advance booking is essential**.



GARDENING HUB - Each season, we carefully select beautiful, mostly English-grown annuals, perennials, and specimen plants for our quintessentially English garden-style plant centre, based here at Lytham Hall. Our gift shop offers even more to browse, and Greg's knowledgeable team are always on hand to provide expert advice on choosing the best plants for your garden.



ANIMAL HUB - All of our animals have been welcomed through rescue charities and are cared for by a dedicated team of volunteers. We are incredibly grateful for your kind donations, which help us provide food and bedding supplies for our animals. Please do pop in and see them anytime!
