Heritage Trust for the North West is responsible for the management of the Hall and its estate (Reg. Charity number 508300) and receives no regular grants towards maintenance and restoration costs.

The upkeep of Lytham Hall and its Historic Parkland is of paramount importance to ensure it is here to enjoy today and for future generations.

Lytham Hall was once the ancestral home of the colourful Clifton family until the latter part of the 20th Century. The Clifton land-owning dynasty can be traced back to the 1100s on this Lancashire coastline. The first Lytham Hall was a Jacobean timbered mansion built shortly after Sir Cuthbert Clifton acquired the land in 1606. A few generations later, Thomas Clifton commissioned the renowned architect John Carr of York to build the fine Palladian style mansion you'll see today.

In the 12th Century the site was home to a Priory of Benedictine monks which makes it of great archaeological interest. The Georgian Hall is of Grade One listed status which makes it of local and national interest.

As well as historic Hall tours, we have a vast programme of varied events throughout the year. Please see our website and follow our social media channels for more information.
